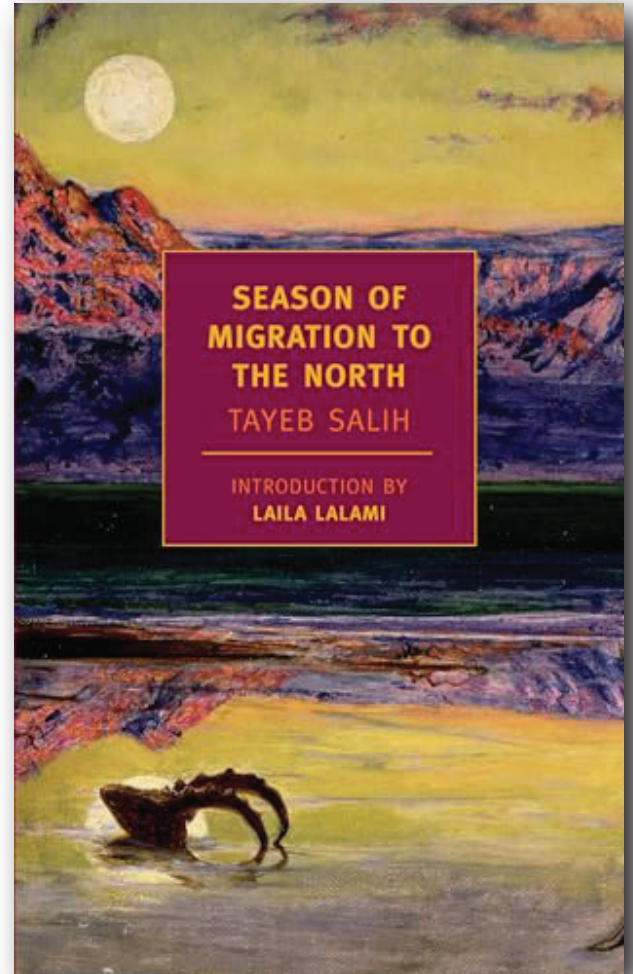

Season of Migration to the North
By Tayeb Salih



In *Season of Migration to the North*, a young Sudanese man returns to his Nile village in the 1960s after studying in Europe, eager to help shape his country's postcolonial future. He discovers a stranger among the familiar faces of childhood—the enigmatic Mustafa Sa'eed. Mustafa takes the young man into his confidence, telling him the story of his own years in London and of his brilliant career as an economist. When Mustafa suddenly disappears, the young man is left in an unsettled and violent no-man's-land between Europe and Africa.

Season of Migration was selected in 2001 by a panel of Arab writers and critics as the most important Arab novel of the twentieth century.

About the Author

Tayeb Salih (1929-2009) was born in northern Sudan and educated at the University of Khartoum. After a brief period working as a teacher, he moved to London to work with the BBC Arabic Service. Salih later worked as director general of information in Qatar, and then with UNESCO in Paris.
